Dear Ms. Simstad:

As promised at the April 12, 1995 meeting with representatives of Southdown, Inc. (Southdown), **Panterra** Corporation (Panterra) and Ernie Neal, we are providing this monthly update on activities conducted at the Landfill No. 1 site. The purpose of this update is to keep the Agency informed on the nature and extent of site developments in the event that inquiries arise.

During the past month, measurement of ground water levels and surface water flows was conducted and the results were incorporated into the site database. Seven ground water monitoring wells were installed to better define the ground water quality at the site. Additional wells will be installed in November to complete this ophase of the work. Thus far, the work has progressed as expected and we anticipate a final written report by the first week of February, 1997.

I trust that the above is sufficient to keep the Agency informed of the activities performed to date at the Landfill No. 1 site. Should you need additional information, please feel free to contact me at (713) 653-6956.
