Dear Ms. Simstad:

As promised at the April 12, 1995 meeting with representatives of Southdown, Inc. (Southdown), Panterra Corporation (Panterra) and Ernie Neal, we are providing this monthly update on activities conducted at the Landfill No. 1 site. The purpose of this update is to keep the Agency informed on the nature and extent of site developments in the event that inquiries arise.

During the past month, measurement of ground water levels and surface water flows was conducted and the results were incorporated into the site database. In addition, on July 9, 1996 Panterra issued its' final report on the evaluation of various dust suppressant alternatives.-

At a meeting with USX, Corp. on May 22, 1996 the parties agreed to proceed with conducting a Phase II investigation to evaluate further the remedial alternatives for Landfill No. 1. Panterra, Corp. has submitted to both Southdown and USX the proposed Phase II investigation and it still is currently being reviewed.

I trust that the above is sufficient to keep the Agency informed of the activities performed to date at the Landfill No. 1 site. Should you need additional information, please feel free to contact me at (713) 653-6956.
