Dear Ms. **Simstad**:

As promised at the April 12th meeting with representatives of Southdown, Inc. (Southdown), **Panterra** Corporation (Panterra) and Ernie Neal, we are providing this monthly update on activities conducted at the Landfill No. 1 site. The purpose of this update is to keep the Agency informed on the nature and extent of site developments in the event that inquiries arise.

During the past month, the measurement of ground water levels and surface water flows continued to be collected. In addition, observation of the pilot test applications of potential CKD cover materials continued. As stipulated in the scope of work for this project, monitoring of ground water and surface water will continue for four months following re-establishment of drainage of the on-site pond. This information will be used to evaluate the effects of this new condition on the hydrology of the site. A report will be generated during the week of February 19, 1996 which will describe the work to date and a follow-up report will be issued in June, 1996 to complete documentation of the dust suppression pilot testing.

I trust that the above is sufficient to keep the Agency informed of the activities performed to date at the Landfill No. 1 site. Should you need additional information, please feel free to contact me at (713) 653-6956.
