

1 MR. SHAPIRO: Mr. Mason.

2 MR. MASON: I value completeness and
3 accuracy in the work when people work for me
4 or with me. I know the director who I work
5 for values the same.

6 The reason I moved to table was
7 because I would like to hear additional
8 information. That being not available,
9 based on the present information, I can not
10 support the permit; so, therefore, I'll vote
11 in support of the motion.

12 MR. SHAPIRO: Chairman Ioannides.

13 CHAIRMAN IOANNIDES: I've thought
14 very carefully about my concerns in regard
15 to some of the technical information
16 presented to us. To be balanced, one of the
17 concerns also I have is I did not receive
18 adequate information in regard to what is --
19 when we look at the hypothetical situation
20 of certain conditions occurring and we look
21 at the risk factors, what are the
22 probabilities of those risk factors.

23 I was not able to receive adequate
24 information that I could say the other

1 probabilities are so unlikely, therefore,
2 I'm comfortable. For that reason, I have to
3 rely on my expert and vote yes.

4 MR. SHAPIRO: Mr. Chairman, the
5 motion to deny the permit is approved, four
6 voting yes, one voting no.

7 CHAIRMAN IOANNIDES: Mr. Shapiro,
8 will you prepare the necessary documents
9 consistent with the Board's action at this
10 meeting and for Board members signatures and
11 journalization.
